IMPORTANT PROPERTY TAX INFORMATION DUE TO HURRICANE IAN

Your tax collector is very sensitive to the needs of citizens and property owners affected by the recent damage due to Hurricane Ian; however, state law still requires the tax collector to mail and collect 2022 property tax bills. **Please read the important information below.**

1. The recently mailed Property Tax Notices represent taxes assessed as of January 1, 2022 and are for the 2022 year.
2. Property taxes are payable anytime between now and March 31, 2023. Please keep in mind there is no penalty for late payment until after March 31, 2023, and you do receive a discount if you pay early.
3. **The Governor’s Executive Order (EO) 22-242 provides for an extension of the November 4% discount period until January 31, 2023, as well as an extension of the March 31, 2023, payment deadline until May 31, 2023, if your property has been completely destroyed and/or is otherwise rendered uninhabitable. If you believe your property qualifies for the extension, please sign the statement below and return it to the Collier County Tax Collector’s office.**
